

Krugerrand - did you know?

Did you know: The Krugerrand has been launched in 1967

Did you know: The Krugerrand was the first legal tender gold bullion coin to gain worldwide use

Did you know: Krugerrands are legal tender, but have no recorded face value on the coin.

Did you know: Krugerrands are valued for their gold content

Did you know: Krugerrands are worth their weight in gold, the 1oz Krugerrand coin contains exactly 1 troy-ounce fine gold, therefore its value is based on the current gold price

Did you know: Krugerrands are ounce-denominated bullion coins

Did you know: the Krugerrand is made from 22 carat gold

Did you know: The use of 22 carat gold in the Krugerrand, makes the coin more durable and less easy to damage while being traded

Did you know: A small amount of copper is added to the 22 carat gold Krugerrand to give the coin its rose gold finish

Did you know: Since 1967 there have been more than 60 million Krugerrands sold, making it the most traded gold coin in the world

Did you know: Krugerrand is a world renowned brand making it easily tradable

Did you know: The design of the Krugerrand is unchanged since 1967, this consistency makes it more valuable, as all years of production of the coin are tradable

Did you know: The Krugerrand is still the best way to own gold, since 1967

Did you know: Due to its design and weight, Krugerrands are easy to store and transport

Did you know: The business of the Krugerrand is managed as a joint venture between Rand Refinery and the South African Mint (a subsidiary of the South African Reserve Bank)

Did you know: The South African Mint, a subsidiary of the South African Reserve Bank is the only authorised body to mint legal tender coins, like the Krugerrand, adding to the coins reliability and value that endures

Did you know: Rand Refinery is one of the world's leading gold refineries, since 1921

Did you know: Rand Refinery is the largest integrated single-site precious metals refining and smelting complex in the world

Did you know: Rand Refinery has refined almost one third of all the gold mined worldwide

Did you know: Only ethically produced and sourced gold is used in the manufacture of Krugerrands
